Graduation Checklist and Instructions

God's Crime Scene for Kids

God's Crime Scene for Kids was written to be completed at one of three different levels:

- 1. Read the book in its entirety.
- 2. Read the book and answer the questions in the CSI Assignment boxes (using the margins of the book or a separate piece of paper).
- 3. Read the book, answer the questions in the CSI Assignment boxes, download and complete the fill-ins and activity sheets for each chapter.

If your cadet decides to tackle Level 3, encourage him or her to assemble the printed materials into an Academy Notebook. You'll even find a Notebook Cover Page on the "The Mystery: Things That Go Bump in the Night" webpage. Once your cadet has completed one of these three levels (as described above), he or she may graduate from the Academy and print out the *Certificate of Promotion*. You'll find two links on the graduation page at our website: one for an image you can print, and one for a PowerPoint file. If you print the image of the certificate, you can simply fill in the name of your cadet in the blank space. If you have PowerPoint, you can customize your cadet's graduation certificate in the following way:

- 1. Open the "Graduation Certificate" PowerPoint file
- 2. Hover your mouse over the "Insert Student's Name Here" text. When the pointer turns into a cursor, select the text and edit it by typing in your cadet's name, replacing "Insert Student's Name Here"
- 3. If your cadet read *God's Crime Scene for Kids* and answered the questions in the CSI Assignment boxes, edit the "with Distinction (or Great Distinction)" line to read: "with Distinction"
- 4. If your cadet read *God's Crime Scene for Kids*, printed the fill-in sheets and activities, completed them and assembled them into an Academy Notebook, edit the "with Distinction (or Great Distinction)" line to read: "with Great Distinction"
- 5. Under the "File" menu, select "Print" and follow the prompts to print the certificate.
